

- The double is a theme that haunts Linda Lê. It is certainly linked to the status of the writer of dual culture. The double resides not only in the splitting of the author into a character/narrator but also in a very symbolic way in the perception of the Self.
- More than once, the writer has metaphorically compared her own story to that of two twins, the survival of one having to be paid for by the life of the other
